Sobriety with dignity

The all-new Welcome House Recovery Center is open!

Hopes, dreams, and a community coming together. The Recovery for Life Campaign is not only making way for an all-new Welcome House Recovery Center, but also leading the way for sobriety with dignity.

On July 23, 2023, the first residents were welcomed to the intentionally designed 28,000 square-foot residential recovery center. Even with expanded bed capacity – from 80 to 100 – within three weeks, every bed was occupied.

Nearly every aspect of the Center is mindfully designed for a healthy and dignified recovery. Features include dorm-style residence rooms; family-friendly gathering areas; multi-use class and meeting rooms; a fitness room; a clinical and in-take suite; computer stations and kitchenettes; and serenity spaces for respite and reflection.

Outdoor features include a patio and deck and a soon-to-be constructed parking area, half-court basketball zone, and gathering spaces.

The Campaign continues - and every gift counts!

Though our facility is open and final projects are under construction, Welcome House is striving to raise \$2.2M that remains of the \$14.2M project.

Not surprisingly, steep spikes in construction costs pre- and post-pandemic resulted in significant increases in the initial budget. Thankfully, many generous individuals, foundations, and corporations have generously supported this endeavor. It's not too late to share a one-time gift or a pledge. Every gift – no matter the amount – is needed and appreciated!

Your gift to the campaign offers tax savings!

Until April 1, 2025, your gift may also result in a tax credit for your business. For every \$1.00 donated, \$0.55 will be returned as a tax credit certificate, valid for the next ten years to reduce your Missouri tax liability.




Income levels at in-take

- achieving sustained sobriety and continuing as active 12-Step Program members;
- building healthy, positive relationships;
- adopting a healthy lifestyle which includes proper nutrition;
- attaining skills to secure and maintain employment and achieving personal and financial stability; and
- · leading productive and meaningful lives.

The coordinated care approach supports the best possible outcomes for each participant and aligns with the best evidence-based practices in addiction recovery.
